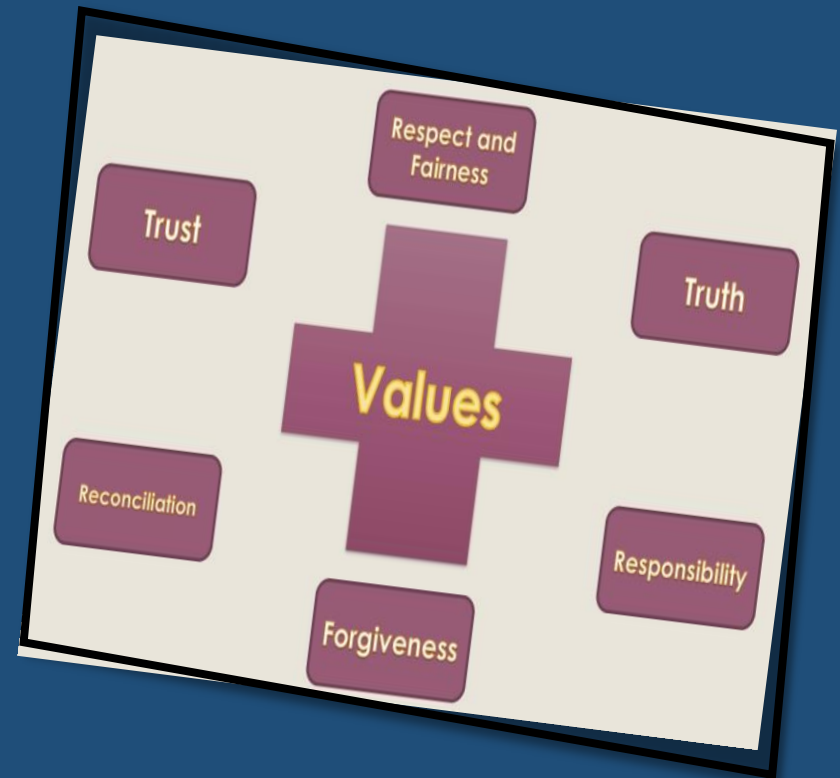
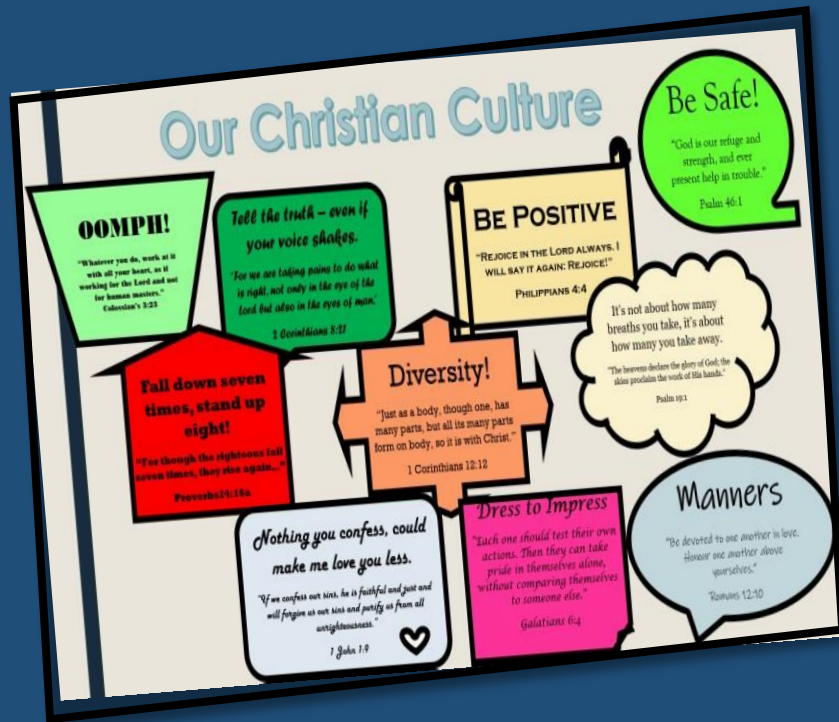

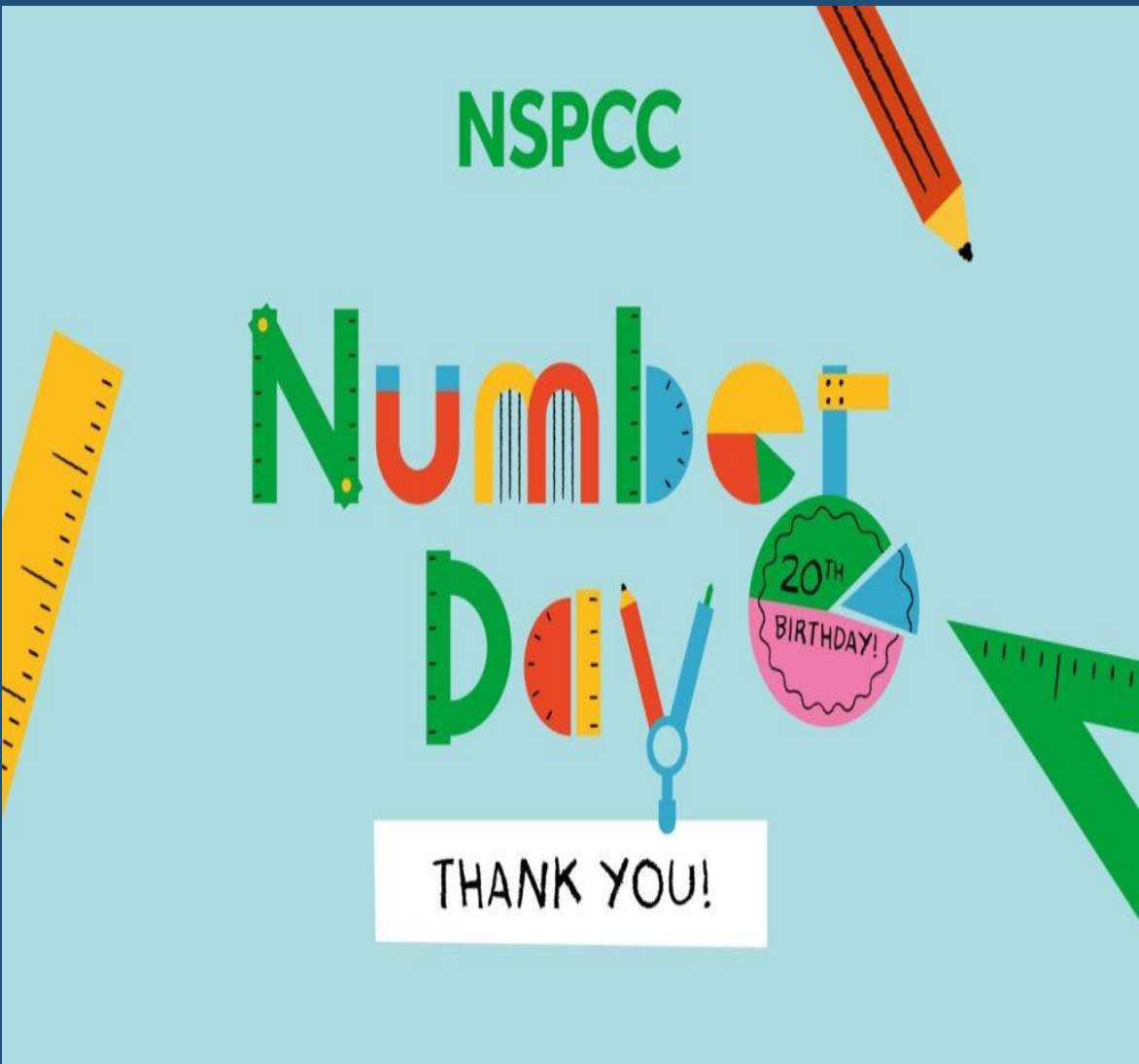

On Friday 22nd October 2021, we raised £164.45 for Nuneaton foodbank by holding a non-uniform day

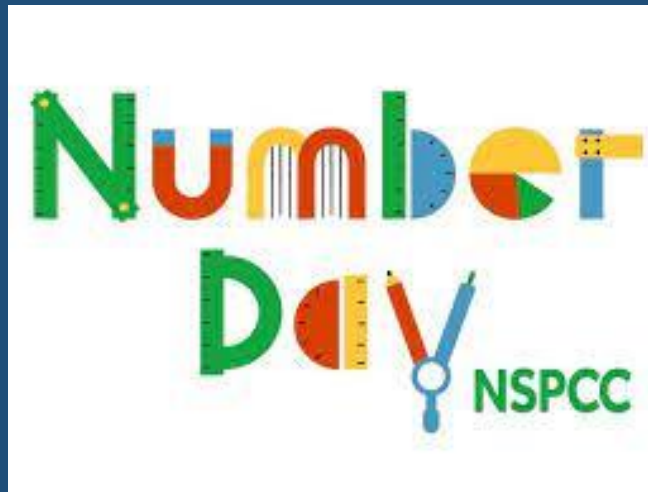
